- Rosewood exhibit application  
Ronnie proposed that the application process be delayed until April 2017 for a show in 2018. That should not deter the membership from working on quilts **now** to be submitted on the application.  
"Water" (of some sort) was decided as the general theme for the exhibit work  
The work should have a perimeter no larger than 192 inches and no smaller than 96 inches.  
3D work on the quilts and 3D sculpture (with fabric as a major component) is encouraged  
Past shows at Rosewood have had things hanging from the ceiling
