- Program: Sculptural forms with fabric by Janet Lasley

NOTES:

Form the design you desire with fabric (quilted or not)

Stuff or use a form to hold it in position

Do any sewing or embellishment with beads, etc

Cover with stiffener, thinly but completely

Let dry overnight

**glue is diluted 1/3 water to 2/3 glue

Use several thin coats rather than one thick coat

Glue will ruin your paint brush, be sure to clean it out before it dries

Regular Elmer's glue works best

Use wax paper to protect surfaces and to transport your project if it isn't dry
