Shannon and Barb offered to work with Carroll on sharing technical responsibilities. Carroll said that we had lost old minutes on the website when we had website changes but she relinked last year's minutes which should show up. Carroll has all the minutes and Ann has several year's worth if anyone needs them.

Chris and Barb spoke about the upcoming Art in the City that MVAQN has registered for. It is Saturday, August 6 from 1-7. We do not have a location for our space yet. Chris and Barb will have a tent and netting from which to hang small quilts with clothespins. In case of rain, we will not participate. If you have small quilts that you would like to display, please get them to Barb before August. (quiltedbybarb@gmail.com) or 865-382-3729. If you want them for sale, please let her know the price. If you would like to be at the booth on August 6, bring a folding chair. We do have a small club banner and several unclaimed crazy quilt squares that we can exhibit. Ann will bring bookmarks to give out. We discussed handouts but decided to have a large QR code (Carroll will make)and bookmarks instead. Barb and Chris will have final say in which overall quilts to hang in the space.

Carroll mentioned the remaining 5 Dayton Landmark Quilts that have not been sold. We decided to put them in the Yellow Springs Arts Council Show in 2023. The quilts are the Mendelson, Wayne Ave. view, Courthouse Square, Patterson Monument, and the DAI.

Carroll will continue being “Exhibition Chair” but needs any outstanding hanging materials so they are in one place.

Ann mentioned that she would like to see the Redlining quilt that Shannon and Carroll made. It is currently at the Montgomery Co. Bldg. Auditor’s office third floor before moving to its permanent place at Sinclair Community College in August. Ann will suggest a field trip/lunch date in July to see the quilt. Congrats to Shannon and Carroll for finishing such an important community project!

We talked about new leadership for the group since Joni, Jennifer and Peggy are finished with their terms. With Covid interruption the typical rotation via by-laws was suspended. Ronnie suggested that we continue to set aside by-laws until the beginning of 2023 and figure out meetings month by month. Carroll offered to organize this until we vote on a new board. In the meantime, Chris will continue to be Treasurer and Ann the secretary. Shannon will continue as chair for Study Group which reconvenes in September. Jennifer will reserve the church for Sept-November for meetings. There will be no meeting at the church in July or August (field trip in July and Art in the City in August).

We voted to participate in the Yellow Springs Arts Council show for 2023. Chris will keep us posted.

For September’s meeting we decided to have a brainstorming session, and a “Getting to Know you” by Ronnie Doyal.
