Maxine Thomas was invited by Michigan State University Museum to create a piece for the Tutu Foundation quilt exhibition which opens October 1, 2016 in Cape Town, South Africa in conjunction with the October birthdays of Desmond and Leah Tutu and the annual Desmond Tutu International Peace lecture at the University of Western Cape. The exhibit will be held at the new Desmond and Leah Tutu Foundation headquarters in the historic Granary building. The quilts will subsequently travel to several venues.

Her entry, *Radiance Rose*, was selected by Juror Niloo Paydar for SAQA's juried exhibition *Dialogues: Contemporary Responses to Marie Webster Quilts*.
