TIP:

When using a rotary cutter the more vertical you hold the cutter to what you are cutting, the more accurate your cut will be. Also, always use a sharp blade for a good cut.

**multiple cards from one piece of stiffening TIP from Marylyn Doyle

When you making multiple fabric post card which are not event specific such as a birthday, anniversary, or a holiday, for 4"x 6" cards measure a 8 1/2" x 13" sheet of stiffened pellon (I use Timtex and Wonder Under/BondaWeb) or whatever you use, then decorate the top with paint, adhere shapes to the entire piece, and sew. When finished, cut out the 4" x 6" postcards, you'll get 4, affix a back whether of fabric or card, stitch around the edges to secure all the layers. Write a greeting, address and mail.
