STUDY GROUP Tuesday October 4, 2022

We will be making "Pop Art Portraits" as outlined in Quilting Arts April/May 2019 pg. 27-30. At the evening session we will be making the design template and possibly fusing fabrics. You do need to do a little homework ahead of time.

*Please find a photo of someone you think would be interesting to capture in wild colors. (I used my I-phone to crop a picture of my grandson to a shoulder/head shot and also to change it to B/W. Then I emailed it to myself and printed it from the email.)

*Print a black and white copy of the photo on your home computer. If you want it enlarged, take it to a copy center. I took mine to Office Depot and the staff helped me with using the copier (29c a page) to enlarge it to my desired size.

*Bring your enlarged photo to our study group along with:

A Sharpie

Lightweight paper

A lightbox if you have one

Mechanical pencil

Paper-backed fusible web such as Wonder-Under

Fat quarter black batik (or other tight weave) for the applique. I found this at Sew-a lot.

(I will bring an iron, small ironing board and one light box).

At home you will need several bright fabrics such as stripes, small dot or tone-on-tone prints for the figures. I used my background print instead of the muslin in the directions. Also you will need batting and backing.
